CIRCULAR

Sub:- Instructions regarding non transferring of officers
and officials appointed for Census 2011 till 31-03-2011.
Ref:- DO. letter No. 9/11/2010- CD (CEN) Dated: 12-02-2010
Of Sri Gopal.K.Pillai, Home Secretary, Government of
India, North Block, New Delhi.

The Preparations for the conduct of 2011 Census are in full swing. The first phase of this operation, i.e., Houselisting and Housing Census is scheduled to be conducted in the period April-July 2010. The details required for the preparation of the National Population Register (NPR) will also be conducted during this phase. The second phase of Census Operations would be conducted from 9th February to 5th March 2011.

The process of appointment of Census Officers at the State, District, Taluk level and up to the Enumeration Block has already commenced in the State. The Training of these functionaries has also started. These officers are required to discharge statutory functions under the Census Act, 1948 and under the Citizenship Act, 1955. It is important that once appointed, they are not shifted till the entire Census operation is over. Government of India under Rule 8 (vi) of the Census Rules 1990 imposes restrictions on the Head of Department/Officer on the transfer of officers/officials once appointed as Supervisor/Enumerator, without the proper consent of Principal/District Census Officer.

Hence according to the instructions of the Government of India, vide letter cited under reference, State Government (under Rule 8 (vi) of the Census Rules 1990) issues instructions to all the Heads of Departments, Principal Secretaries and Secretaries of various Departments that "**Officers appointed for Census 2011 are not transferred till 31 March 2011**" without the proper consent of Principal/District Census Officer.
